Join us on a visit to the **Lyndhurst Mansion** and the **Philipsburg Manor** in Historic Upper Westchester and enjoy a buffet luncheon at the scenic Red Hat on the River Restaurant.

The Lyndhurst Mansion is designated as a National Historic Landmark. This sixty-seven-acre park beside the Hudson River in Tarrytown stands as an outstanding example of 19th century landscape design. The Lyndhurst Manor is a splendid iconic example of a Gothic Revival mansion.

The **Philipsburg Manor**, located in Sleepy Hollow is a living museum, offering visitors a time travel experience back to 1750, when Philipsburg Manor was a thriving milling and trading complex. The Manor is an architectural example of an 18th Century English Manor House.
